

GETTING ALONG IN EL JARDIN

There are a couple of things you'll need to know about El Jardin:

- Adults can seek contact with helpers or agencies. If you are an adult, you can expand on your part as long as your actions fit with what is in your book.
- Follow the times in your book as much as possible. If you miss your court date, should you have one, you won't be able to make it up! The Judge is very busy and runs a tight ship.
- Sometimes our community folks are stretched rather thin. If they are not in, you may be asked to draw a card and follow the action on the card.
- You should expect to pay for services. If you don't have money, see the Mayor or a Messenger. Sometimes they have odd jobs and can pay for those.
- Public meetings like Parenting Classes and AA meetings are announced. If your character should attend, make sure you do so.
- Remember to check your language buttons often. If you need to use an interpreter to help you understand someone, make sure you find one.
- At the end of the simulation, you'll be asked to return to the location at which you began the day. You'll take the props and notebooks back to that seat as well.

In the meantime, though, take a few minutes to read the materials, don the props, and get ready for a great experience. It's our experience that the more you get into your part, the more you get out of your part, so let's get started!
